Saturday Education session at break: Walnut Creek history and Watershed Geography. 9am-noon Weed @ secondary buffer sites and install sheet mulching to suppress weeds to prepare for planting next fall OR 4) Plant forbs @ top of bank near picnic area. 5) Plant yarrow seed gathered in October. 6) Water in the new plants. Monitor new plants for water needs and predation by insects & animals. 1) Feb. 13 Water and install predation protection if necessary 2) 3) Continue planting any remaining grass & forbs to fill in for plants that died.
